Charges payable by importers to Hull & Goole Port Health Authority (HGPHA)

Import Checks on Non-EU Fishery Products

The EU lays down the minimum harmonised charge in Euros for imports of certain animal products. The charges are calculated according to the gross tonnage of the consignment, rounded up to the next full tonne. The EU do not stipulate a currency conversion rate and no official rate for 2020 has been confirmed. HGPHA has therefore decided to keep the charges at the 2019 rate unless we are informed of any changes.

The charges applicable from 1 January 2020 are as shown below: -

- Consignments up to 6 tonnes are subject to a minimum charge of £49.36 per consignment.
- Additional tonnage between 7-46 tonnes is charged at £8.08 per tonne.
- For consignments over 46 tonnes, a maximum charge of £376.91 applies.
- Frozen Fishery Products from New Zealand (in accordance with the EU Equivalence Agreement) are subject to reduced charges as shown below: -
- Consignments up to 6 tonnes are subject to a minimum charge of £38.26 per consignment.
- Additional tonnage between 7-46 tonnes £6.26 per tonne.
- Consignments over 46 tonnes are charged at a maximum of £292.55 per consignment.
- Any additional sampling requirements will incur additional charges on a cost recovery basis.

Import Checks on non-EU High-risk Products not of Animal Origin

- Documentary check - £60 per consignment.
- Identity Check (partial turn-out) - £110 per consignment.
- Physical Checks (full turn-out) £200 per consignment.
- Plus, sampling, analysis, and transport costs on a cost recovery basis.
